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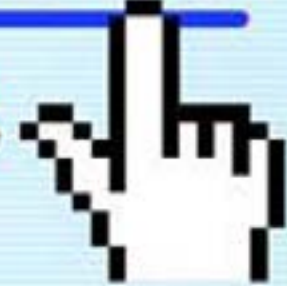
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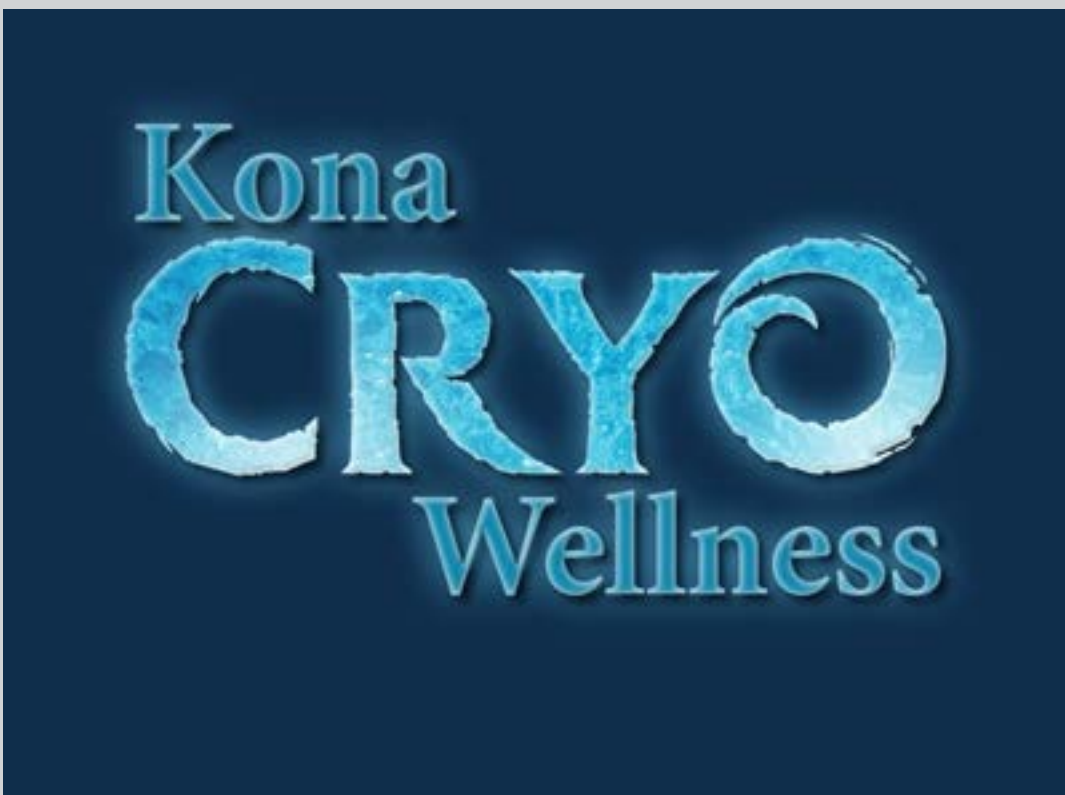
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His research work on humpback whales started in Hawaii in the early 1970's. The 18-year-old Dan migrated to Alaska to study these on their feeding grounds. In 1989, he was selected by the federal government as one of four marine mammal scientists to assess the potential impacts of the Exxon Valdez oil spill on humpback whales and killer whales in Alaska.

Recently, Dan has been working with researchers from Hawaii to better understand some of the world's least known species of whales. This work includes learning more about the potential impacts of heavy tourism on whales. He is also collecting information on cetacean population sizes and seasonal movements and breeding of populations, as well as understanding how these would be affected by any oil spill in the Hawaiian Islands.

His research work has been published in National Geographic, government and scientific journals such as Marine Mammal Science and Canadian Journal of Marine Mammalogy.

Dan's lifetime knowledge of and experience around whales has made him the selection of film crews from the U.S. and foreign countries filming whale documentaries and feature films. His work with whales has been featured on local, state and national news and TV specials including the Discovery Channel and National Geographic. His photography has appeared in magazines like Audubon and GEO.

Captain Dan has personally conducted whale watching adventures in Kona since the mid 1970's, introducing tens of thousands of visitors and residents to the amazing world of wild whales. His trips are internationally renowned for their excellence.

RESEARCH OF THE WILD WHALE RESEARCH FOUNDATION

DAN AND THE WILD WHALE RESEARCH

The waters around Hawaii are home to a variety of whales and dolphins (cetaceans) and provide a unique opportunity to learn about some of the world's least known species of whales. Dan and the Wild Whale Research Foundation have been studying the biology of many of these species since 1973, adding to the body of scientific information about these creatures and help to better protect these environments.

ROBIN

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. **Does experience around whales really matter to successful whale watching?**
 A. Most have done many trips to find you a whale to watch but that's where the experience to anticipate the habits of these wild creatures so you can get work following a whale that's not doing much. Dan uses his lifetime of experience to find you the best time to see a whale.

2. **Is there a no advantage to going in the morning or the afternoon?**
 A. The whales will be there, so it's up to you. Morning means lighter weather, cooler air temperatures, generally calmer water and better lighting for photography. Maybe your lucky clock is at noon - many visitors come back from many many hours of Hawaii. If you go to get early, take the morning sun. If you do to sleep in on the last trip.

3. **Are the whales more active at a certain time of day?**
 A. Whales don't punch clocks. They get active when they turn on other whales, morning or afternoon. The question is how to find them, and Dan knows where they like to hang out. If you go in the prime time they congregate, you'll usually see more activity.

4. **What's the chance some operators make about "certified whale naturalist or researcher"?**
 A. It's usually a person who took a short course, maybe made a few books on Hawaii's humpback whales, but probably doesn't have much real experience with these big and wild creatures.

5. **What's the difference between whale "watching" and whale "yumping"?**
 A. Many companies offer "whale watching" as just a job to be done, or worse to create activity like sailing, snorkeling or diving. On these trips you're usually getting only "whale yumping" with no guarantee. There's little time to sleep and watch the whales and not reacting with any wild animal in nature. Whales require time and patience. The longer you watch, the more you'll see.

6. **Where will we go for the best chance to see active whales?**
 A. Most other whale watches out of Kona will stay within a few miles of Kona Harbor. When we go water conditions permitting, Captain Dan will take you to the whale sanctuary north of the Kona Airport, a great bet for a major sighting and active whales.

7. **What's the real story behind people telling us "the whales are all gone"?**
 A. Many take us too far. It's a bit like someone here in Hawaii saying the "birds are all gone". If you look around, you know that's not true. The same is true with whales. In fact, there are many different kinds here "around". Captain Dan should know since he's been here for 30 years. "They're all gone" says Dan a bit.

8. **How does going on Captain Dan's Whale Watch benefit whales?**
 A. One of the best ways to protect wild whales is to conduct quality research. To learn the animals' needs and to find what we can do to improve their well being. For more than 30 years, Captain Dan McSwaney has been known worldwide for his pioneering efforts on behalf of whales and dolphins. His research has led to major management agreements, and these unique creatures. Your presence around contributes to the on-going research and education projects of the Wild Whale Research Foundation.

9. **What do I bring along on the trip?**
 A. Keep your gear to a minimum, but we recommend you bring a camera, sunscreen, and some water. (Bring your own drinking water, we'll provide the bottled water) and maybe a light lunch/snack.

Introduction

The bulk of the volunteers and Board members of ALEDA, USA, the United States Freediving Team, spent USA and the Island of Hawaii, 2002. I invite you to become a contributor to the 2002 Pacific Cup of Freediving.

The 2002 Pacific Cup will be held in Kona, Hawaii from October 28 to November 4, representing the first international freediving competition to be held in the United States. This event is a unique opportunity for international competitors to visit and learn about the United States and share in the culture, beauty and pride of the Hawaiian Islands.

ALEDA, USA was founded in 1999 as a not-for-profit organization to further the sport of freediving in the USA and to establish training standards for the sport. The US Freediving Team has, through the generosity of past contributors, been successful in being able to attend international freediving competitions in Salerno, Italy in 1999; in Pigeon (the first US Dive-off) in 1999 and in Pigeon, Spain in 2001. ALEDA USA considers it an honor to be hosting this year's event.

We are especially gratified that this year's event is being dedicated to honoring legend, humanitarian and scholar Jacques Mayol. Jacques was an enthusiastic supporter of the US Freediving Team as well as a personal friend. The entire freediving community will miss his presence, and we are pleased to be able to offer this small but heartfelt tribute in his life and accomplishments.

This year we are anticipating participation from over 40 countries and expect most of all our "freediving men" to participate. Without doubt this will be an exceptional competition, and most probably, world records will be set. Formerly several record events were included including ABC, Free Immersion, "Static Apnea," "Underwater Swimming for Distance," and "Open Water." We are anticipating an excellent opportunity to be recognized in the community, from a tremendous amount of great will be on the defining edge of one of the world's newest and more fascinating water sports. I hope you will take advantage of this exciting opportunity.

With training and experience, underwater activities can be enjoyed by almost anyone. Freediving activities, both for fun and for professional purposes, are popular underwater sports, but also under development techniques, increase fitness and provide opportunities for water sports recreation at all ages.

Brief History

Freediving in its essentials has existed since the time of the Greeks, and there are many stories of submersed and underwater recovery being performed on a single breath of air. The most famous of the early freedivers, written records of their feats appear as early as 400 BC. Since its inception, freediving has been used as a method of discovery, salvage and the hunting of underwater fish, plants and animals. In the modern world, freediving has become a sport that also includes such activities as freediving competition, underwater hockey, film making and recreational diving.

Historically, Greek and American sailors were among the earliest pioneers of competition freediving. However, it was the Greek diver Jacques Mayol and Elmo Meares in the 1930's and '40's that popularized the sport and led to the worldwide phenomenon that exists today. Meares broke the 30-meter depth barrier in 1961. Mayol then proceeded to set records of 60 meters in 1966, 200 meters in 1976 and finally 100 meters in 1983. Today the men's record stands at 134 meters, set in 2000 by Lou LaPenna of France, and the women's record in 136 meters, held by Shelly St. Croix of Canada.

These records were set in the category of freediving known as "No Limits," whereas the first divers to be recognized as freedivers were those who used a buoyancy device. Other categories include: "Variable Weight," descent by descent and ascent by pulling on a cable; "Free Immersion," descent and ascent by pulling along a cable; and "Constant Weight," descent and ascent by self-propulsion, using no weights. "Static Apnea," breath holding and "Dynamic Apnea," underwater swimming for distance, round out the categories.

The "Constant Weight" men's world record is 86 meters, held by Herbert Nitsch of Austria. Tanya Bronger of the USA holds the women's record at 70 meters. This year's event includes "Constant Weight," "Static Apnea" and "Dynamic Apnea."

Competition freediving is rapidly becoming a major sport in the US and the world. International competitions featuring the world's best freedivers are held annually, and the number of freediving clubs and events is increasing exponentially.

JACQUES MAYOL 1927 - 2001

The United States Freediving Team and ALEDA, USA are honored to announce that the 2002 Pacific Cup of Freediving will be dedicated to the memory of Jacques Mayol. The official name of the event will be the "Pacific Cup of Freediving 2002-Jacques Mayol Memorial International Competition."

Jacques was born in Shanghai, China, in 1927. Jacques was the man and his passion for freediving elevated him to the status of the "Grandfather" of freediving. His legendary record worldwide after the release of the cult classic movie The Blue Bird. He established several world records in freediving including the first person to reach 50 meters on a single-breath dive in 1946. He later attained a depth of 100 meters in 1976 and finally in 1983, a depth of 100 meters.

Jacques was lovingly referred to as the "Man Dolphin," a nickname that aptly described his exceptional abilities. He had a kind, gentle disposition. The dolphin often has been referred to as the "Bride of Freediving."

Jacques passed away on December 23, 2001, as the Sullen Island of Elba. Jacques' knowledge of and love for the sea and his passion for freediving will continue to be an inspiration for divers around the world.

THE KONA COFFEE STORY







Kona coffee blooms in February and March. Small white flowers cover the tree and are known as Kona Snow. In April, green berries begin to appear on the trees. By late August, red fruit, called "cherry" because of the resemblance of the ripe berry to a cherry fruit, are starting to ripen for picking. Each tree will be hand-picked several times between August and January, and provides around 20-30 pounds of cherry.

Within 24 hours of picking, the cherry is run through a pulper, the beans are separated from the pulp, and then placed in a fermentation tank overnight. The fermentation time is dependent on the temperature and therefore on the elevation; about 12 hours at a low elevation or 24 hours at a higher elevation. The beans are rinsed and spread to dry on a "hoshidana" or drying rack. Traditional hoshidanans have a rolling roof to cover the beans in the event of rain. It take 7-14 days to dry the beans to an optimal moisture level of between 10-13% (some say 9.5-12.5%). From here, the beans are stored as "pergamino" or parchment. The parchment is milled off the green bean prior to roasting. It takes seven to nine pounds of cherry to make one pound of roasted coffee. Thus 100 pounds of cherry will yield about 12 pounds of roasted coffee.

Kona coffee beans are classified according to the seed type. Type I beans consist of two beans per cherry, flat on one side, oval on the other. Type II beans consist of one round bean per cherry, otherwise known as a Peaberry. Further grading of these two types of beans depends on size, moisture content, purity of bean type and size. The grades of Type I Kona Coffee are Kona Extra Fancy, Kona Fancy, Kona Number 1, and Kona Prime. The grades of Type II Kona coffee are Peaberry Number 1 and Peaberry Prime. There is also a lower grade of coffee called Number 3 which can not legally be labeled as "Kona".

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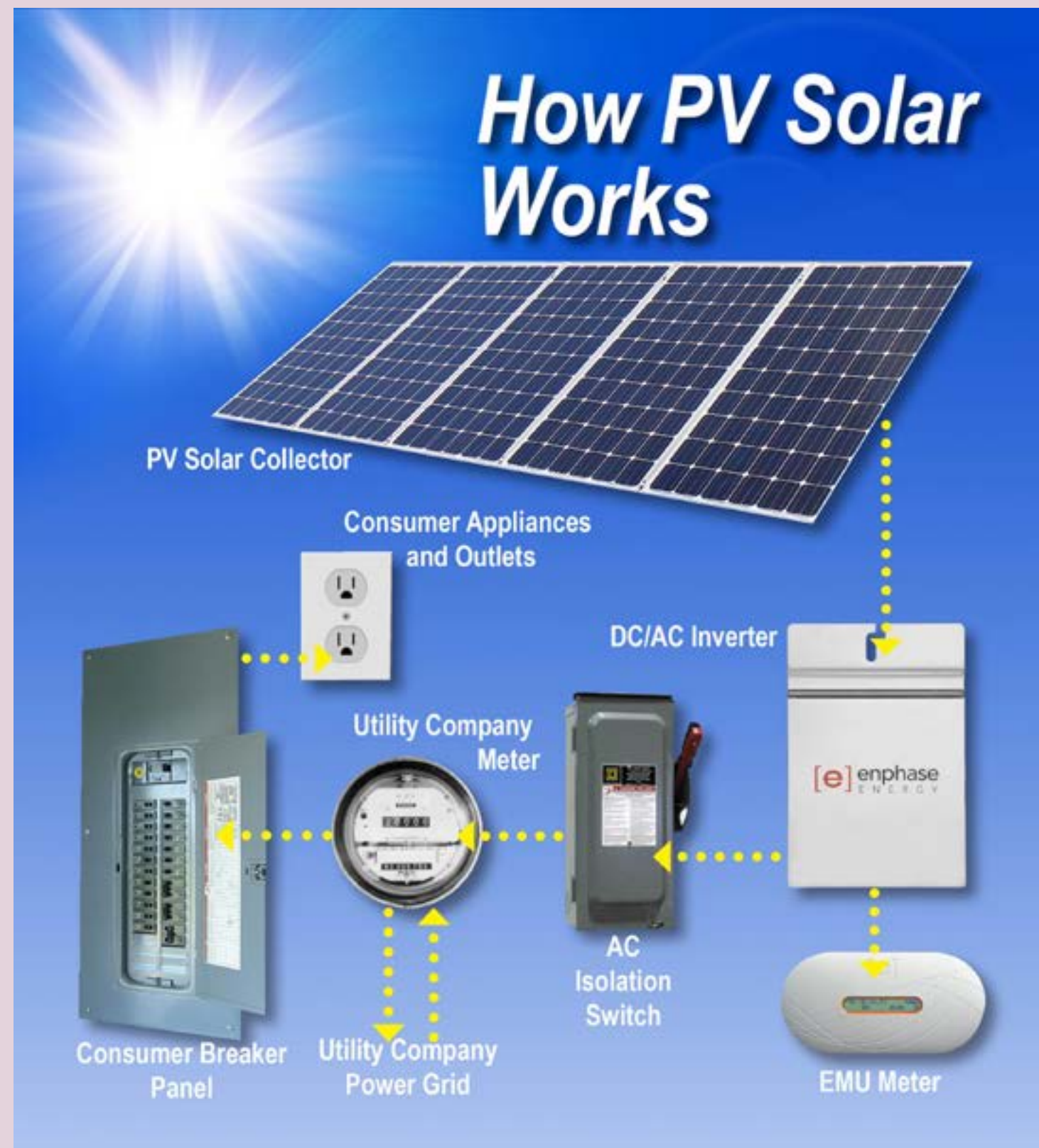

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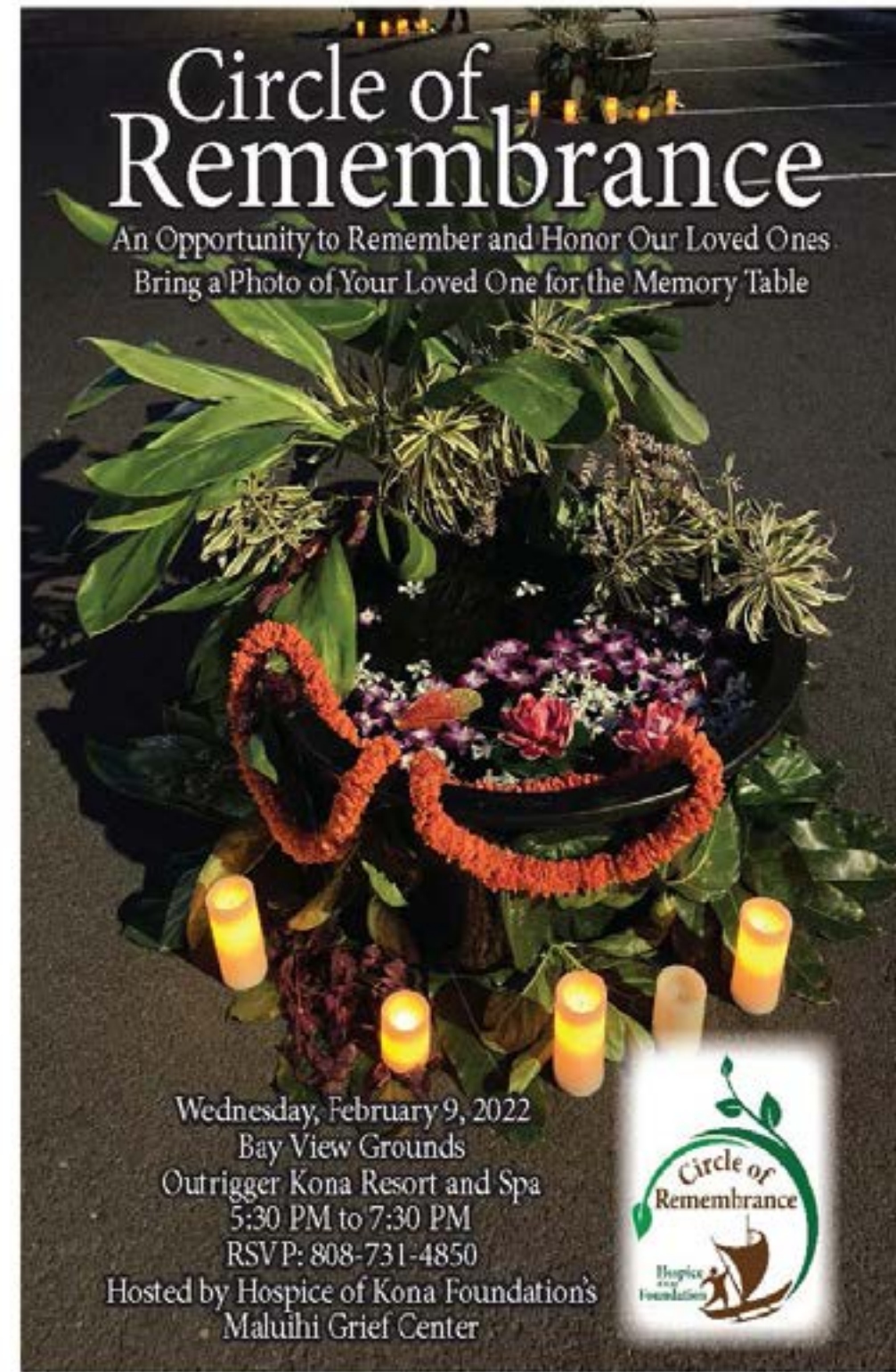

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Nechung Dorje Drayang Ling, established on the Island of Hawaii in 1973 by Venerable Nechung Rinpoche, is a Buddhist temple in the Tibetan tradition. We are affiliated with Nechung Monastery, the home of the Chief State Oracle of Tibet. Nechung in Hawaii is in Wood Valley; the main temple, first constructed in 1902, is of classic design, now painted in brilliant primary colors. Since its inception, over 50 eminent lamas, head and lineage masters of all Tibetan schools, have given teachings, transmissions and initiations of Sutra, Tantra and all levels of the path to enlightenment. Many, such as H.H. the Dalai Lama, have stayed and taught at the temple more than once. Nechung Rinpoche lived at the temple for 8 years, and his reincarnation, now 25 years old, visits on occasion, when he is able to take leave from his monastic studies in Northern India.



The gifts that we are offering for the 2009 Fundraiser are items special to Nechung Dorje Drayang Ling. Some, like the CD of the temple's evening practice, chanted by the Nechung monks, have been an ongoing request by many. George Francis Collins passed away in 1977. Prior to his passing he resided in Kailua-Kona on the Big Island of Hawaii with his wife Nancy. He was the author of several books including *Goodbye South Arabia* and *Hard Eight*.

In *The Mānoa Gang*, Collins relates many humorous anecdotes of growing up in Mānoa Valley on O'ahu, Hawaii, as well as adult exploits such as painting the median stripes down the length of Kalia Avenue in Waikiki a bright green to celebrate St. Patrick's Day.

Hulihee Palace - Kailua-Kona
 Built in 1838 by Governor John Adams Kuaiy, Hulihee Palace retained a colonial aura for Hawaii nearly until 1916. The historic two-story structure, now a museum, displays a collection of former Hawaiian royal furniture and effects, as well as ancient artifacts owned and maintained by the Daughters of Hawaii. Surrounded by an elegant garden of lawn and trees, the palace is an All Drive access from Makalei Church, a handsome coral-and-lava sanctuary built for the island's first Christian. 329-1817. 'Imiloa Astronomy Center of Hawaii - Hilo Ad Pg 55
 Imiloa offers visitors an authentic Hawaiian journey through time and space. This experience includes the Kumu Lupa chart and astronomer insights into the origins of the universe from a scientific point of view. Ahuena Heiau - Kailua-Kona
 While in Kona, be sure to take the time to visit this beautifully restored historical site as you walk through Kailua Village. The Ahuena Heiau (temple), perhaps the most significant historical site in Hawaii, is the place from which King Kamehameha I ruled his united Hawaiian nation. This sacred ground is also where he died on May 8, 1819. • North end of Ali Drive in Kailua-Kona behind the King Kamehameha Kona Beach Hotel. Map 1, B8

Akaka Falls State Park - Hilo
 It wouldn't be a trip to the Big Island of Hawaii without absorbing the splendor of some of the island's waterfalls. 447 high Akaka Falls, main feature of the 65-acre Akaka Falls Park, is at the end of an enchanting but occasionally strenuous 1.2-mile walk through the rainforest. Also in the park is Kahuna Falls. Picnic tables, drinking water and restrooms are available. • Route 19 to Route 222 north of Hilo, 5 miles to park. Map 6, E9

Akatsuka Orchid Gardens - Hilo
 When in Hilo, stop by Hawaii's largest tropical orchid farm, and see what Mother Nature has been up to with a little help from her human hands! You'll see orchids in an array of shapes, sizes and colors on display and for sale. Many plants are already inspected and ready to board the plane or be shipped to the mainland. Open daily, 8:30AM-5:00PM. • Route 11, between mile markers 22 & 23, Glenwood area south of Hilo. Map 5, K11

Ancient Fishponds - Mauna Lani
 The owners of Mauna Lani Resort have done a wonderful job restoring and maintaining the ancient Hawaiian fishponds at Kaunapoua. Take a leisurely walking tour around the ponds, and you can see how the native Hawaiians used aquaculture and worked with nature to feed themselves. Also on the property are swimming trails through the lava fields. • Route 19 to Mauna Lani Drive, follow signs to public access parking. Map 3, F9

Holuoaia Village - Kona
 Drive up the winding Hualaia Road to the cool, quiet town of Holuoaia, and you will see a little bit of old Hawaii. Park your car and stroll through the many shops and galleries featuring unique and impressive work from local artisans and craftspeople. Stop by Paul's Place store or the local cafe for some refreshment and aloha. You'll find most galleries open Tuesday-Saturday. • Route 11 south to left on Hualaia Road, left at top on 180. Map 2, F5

Humpback Whale Center - Kailua
 This newly opened exhibition at the Waikoloa Beach Marriott Hotel, adjacent to its tennis center, features extraordinary photographic images and video footage of humpback whales, taken by renowned nature photographers and videographers in Hawaiian and Alaskan waters. Educational materials developed by the National Marine Wildlife Sanctuary and local marine naturalists provide insight into the underwater world of these magnificent mammals. • Waikoloa Resort. Map 3, H9

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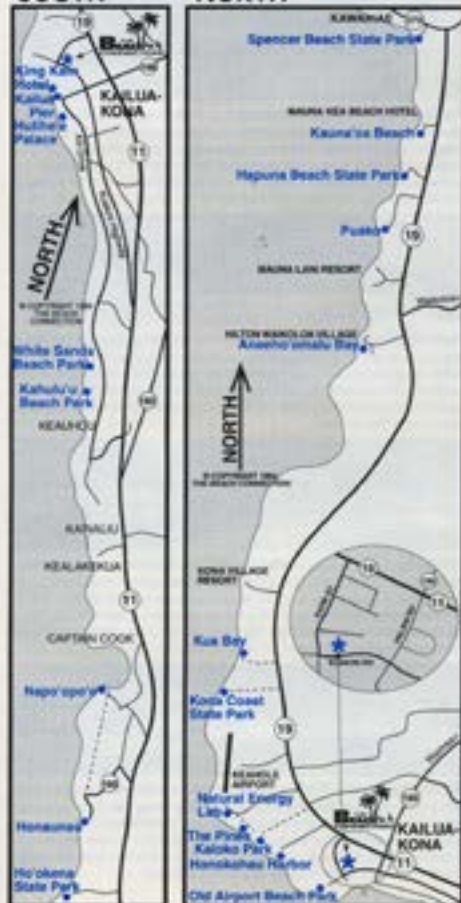
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
